

The following movements on I-275 at Exit 28 (Gandy Blvd) are currently permitted:

- Southbound I-275 to westbound FL 694
- Northbound I-275 to eastbound FL 694
- Northbound I-275 to westbound FL 694
- Westbound FL 694 to southbound I-275
- Eastbound FL 694 to northbound I-275
- Eastbound FL 694 to southbound I-275

FL 694 is the legal name for Gandy Blvd

To Howard Frankland Bridge and Tampa

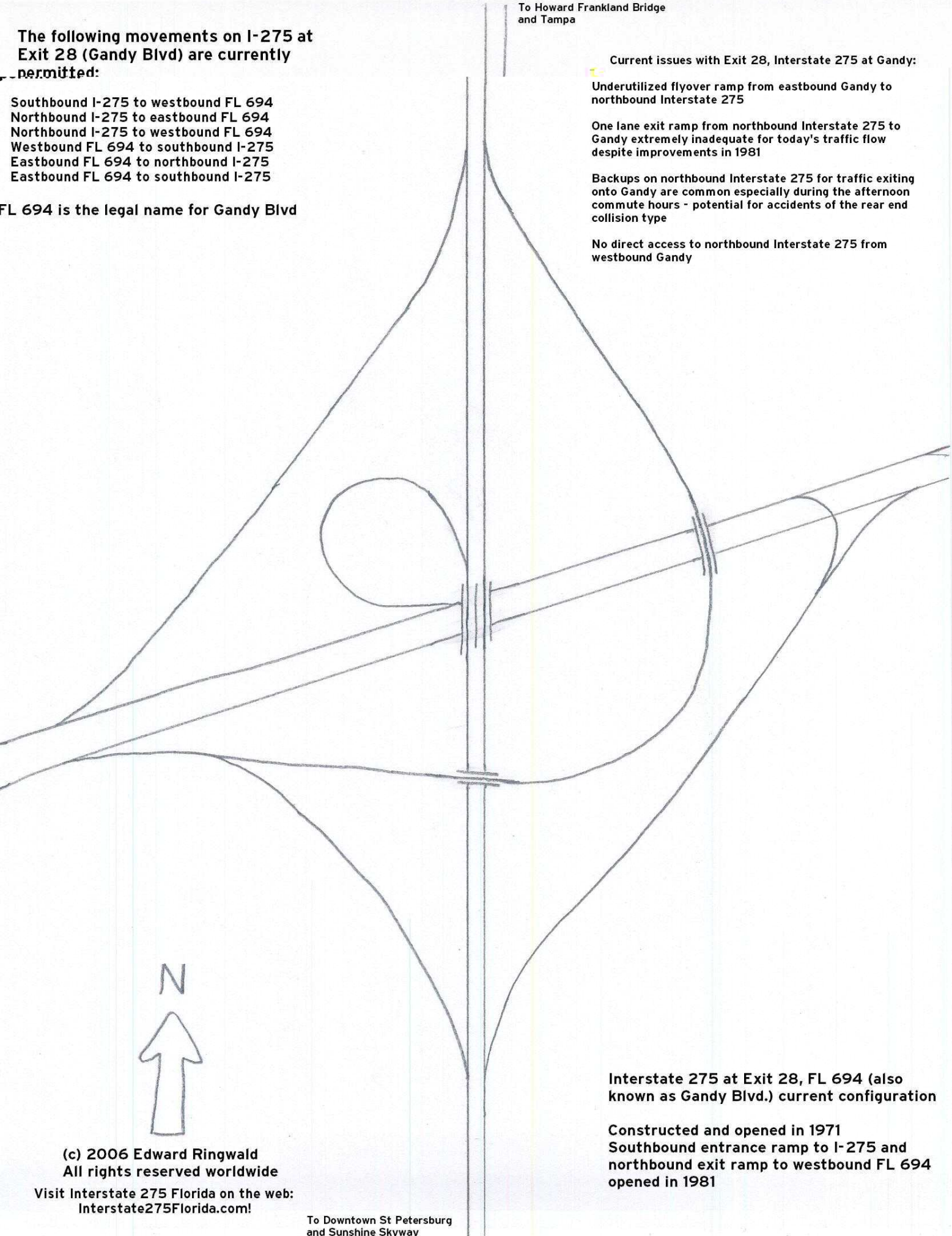
Current issues with Exit 28, Interstate 275 at Gandy:

Underutilized flyover ramp from eastbound Gandy to northbound Interstate 275

One lane exit ramp from northbound Interstate 275 to Gandy extremely inadequate for today's traffic flow despite improvements in 1981

Backups on northbound Interstate 275 for traffic exiting onto Gandy are common especially during the afternoon commute hours - potential for accidents of the rear end collision type

No direct access to northbound Interstate 275 from westbound Gandy

Constructed and opened in 1971
Southbound entrance ramp to I-275 and northbound exit ramp to westbound FL 694 opened in 1981
